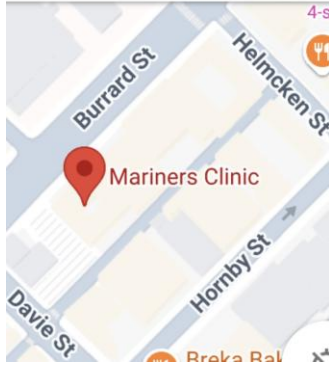

Transport Canada Aviation Medical Exam



At Mariners Medical Clinic, we specialize in occupational medicine in the port of Vancouver. We are licensed by Transport Canada to grant and renew Aviation Medical Certificates, and would be happy to conduct an Aviation Medical Exam for you or an employee. Please call or send an email to book an appointment.

What to expect at your appointment:

We will conduct a comprehensive assessment of your overall health, examine for any pre-existing medical conditions, and establish a medical baseline for continuous monitoring. This involves analyzing a urine sample, testing uncorrected visual acuity and colour perception, as well as conducting a pertinent physical examination. Appointments take 60-90 minutes. Parking can be found under the building or on the street.

What to bring to your appointment:

1. Government Issued ID.
2. Glasses/Contact Lenses (if you wear any).
3. List of Medications.
4. Vision Report within the last year from an Optometrist or Ophthalmologist if this is your first exam and you wear glasses or contacts (please see detailed vision requirements below).
5. Know whether you require an Electrocardiogram (Please see more information on page 2).

Vision Reports must include:

1. Visual acuity measured for distant and near vision, without and with correction (if required) indicating vision in each eye separately and binocular acuity (OD, OS and OU). Please give near vision in Times Roman (N), or the equivalent metric scale.
 2. Comment on any tropias or phorias present in horizontal or vertical planes with measurements in prism diopters accompanied by opinion as to possibility of diplopia.
 3. Measurement of visual fields.
 4. Refractive error, which must be included for an estimate of equivalent spherical error.
 5. Current lens prescription.
 6. Any additional information deemed relevant.
